



**First Lesson / Today's Message – Isaiah 6:1-8**

*Isaiah's vision of heaven took him into God's throne room. The sights and sounds were spectacular.*

**6** In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and exalted, and the train of his robe filled the temple. <sup>2</sup> Above him stood the seraphim. Each one had six wings. With two they covered their faces. With two they covered their feet. With two they flew. <sup>3</sup> One called to another and said,

Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Armies! The whole earth is full of his glory!

<sup>4</sup> The foundations of the thresholds shook at the voice of the one who called, and the temple was filled with smoke.

<sup>5</sup> Then I said, "I am doomed! I am ruined, because I am a man with unclean lips, and I dwell among a people with unclean lips, and because my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of Armies!"

<sup>6</sup> Then one of the seraphim flew to me, carrying a glowing coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. <sup>7</sup> He touched my mouth with the coal and said, "Look, this has touched your lips, so your guilt is taken away, and your sin is forgiven."

<sup>8</sup> Then I heard the Lord's voice, saying, "Whom shall I send? Who will go for us?"  
Then I said, "Here I am. Send me!"

## Second Lesson – Romans 5:1-5

*The Holy Spirit has given us faith in the Son so that we know where we stand with our Heavenly Father.*

5 Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>2</sup> Through him we also have obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand. And we rejoice confidently on the basis of our hope for the glory of God.

<sup>3</sup> Not only this, but we also rejoice confidently in our sufferings, because we know that suffering produces patient endurance, <sup>4</sup> and patient endurance produces tested character, and tested character produces hope. <sup>5</sup> And hope will not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, who was given to us.

## Gospel – John 16:12-15

The Gospel according to John, chapter 16:

**Glory be to you, O Lord!**

*The Father gives all he has to the Son who gives what he has to the Spirit so the Spirit can give what he has to us.*

<sup>12</sup> "I still have many things to tell you, but you cannot bear them now. <sup>13</sup> But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. For he will not speak on his own, but whatever he hears he will speak. He will also declare to you what is to come. <sup>14</sup> He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. <sup>15</sup> Everything the Father has is mine. This is why I said that he takes from what is mine and will declare it to you.

## Confession of Faith – Athanasian Creed (*selected portions*)

*This creed is named after St. Athanasius, a defender of the Christian faith in the fourth century. It was prepared to help the Church battle two errors that undermined Bible teaching. One denied that God's Son and the Holy Spirit are of one being with the Father. The other denied that Jesus Christ is true God and true man in one person.*

*The Athanasian Creed has been traditionally reserved for the Festival of the Trinity. It serves the Christian Church as a standard of the truth. It declared that whoever rejects the doctrine of the Trinity and the doctrine of Christ is without saving faith. Anyone who calls themselves Christian confesses these words. Doctrine worth dying over is doctrine worth confessing.*

*This section of the Athanasian Creed confesses the Bible's teaching about the Triune God and serves as a fitting confession of faith today. (The entire Creed is on pages 284-285 in the hymnal.)*

Whoever wishes to be saved must, above all else, hold to the true Christian faith.

**Whoever does not keep this faith pure in all points will certainly perish forever.**

Now this is the true Christian faith:

**We worship one God in Trinity and Trinity in Unity,  
without mixing the persons or dividing the divine being.**

For each person – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit – is distinct,

**but the deity of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit is one,  
equal in glory and coeternal in majesty.**

What the Father is, so is the Son, and so is the Holy Spirit.

The Father is uncreated, the Son uncreated, the Holy Spirit uncreated;

The Father is infinite, the Son infinite, the Holy Spirit infinite;

The Father is eternal, the Son eternal, the Holy Spirit eternal;

**yet they are not three who are eternal, but there is one who is eternal,  
just as they are not three who are uncreated, nor three who are infinite,  
but there is one who is uncreated and one who is infinite.**

In the same way the Father is almighty, the Son is almighty, the Holy Spirit is almighty;

**yet they are not three who are almighty, but there is one who is almighty.**

So the Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God;

**yet they are not three Gods, but one God.**

So the Father is Lord, the Son is Lord, the Holy Spirit is Lord;

**yet they are not three Lords, but one Lord.**

For just as Christian truth compels us to confess each person individually to be God and Lord,

**so the true Christian faith forbids us to speak of three Gods or three Lords.**

The Father is neither made nor created nor begotten of anyone.

The Son is neither made nor created, but is begotten of the Father alone.

The Holy Spirit is neither made nor created nor begotten,

but proceeds from the Father and the Son.

**So there is one Father, not three Fathers; one Son, not three Sons;  
one Holy Spirit, not three Holy Spirits.**

And within this Trinity none comes before or after; none is greater or inferior,

**but all three persons are coequal and coeternal,**

so that, in every way, as stated before, the Trinity in Unity and Unity in Trinity is to be worshipped.

**Whoever wishes to be saved must have this conviction of the Trinity.**


